Triangle Community Foundation manages \$124 million in funds created by individuals, businesses and families. The Foundation makes grants of more than \$13 million annually and administers a variety of programs – all for the community's benefit.

His mother, Betsy Hutchison, continues a long record of civic involvement through her fund and by serving soup kitchen meals – at the age of 87.

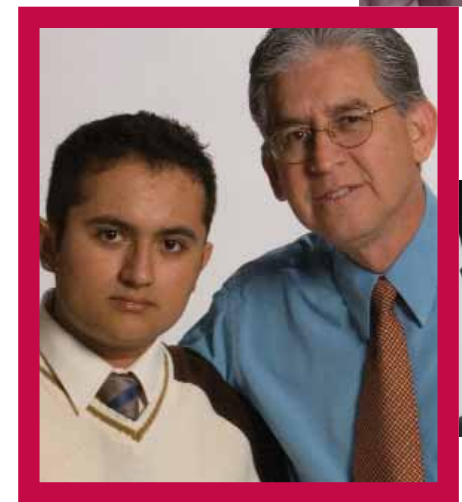

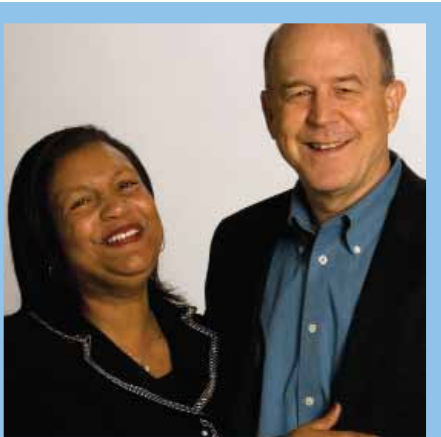

Building a Sustainable *Community*

The residents of sustainable communities enjoy a healthy environment, social equity, economic prosperity – and an unshakable faith in their community’s future. Foundation Board member Frank Phoenix invests in these goals through the Phoenix Fund, which supports EmPOWERment, Inc.’s efforts to rebuild traditionally African-American neighborhoods in Orange and Chatham Counties. Led by Delores Bailey, EmPOWERment ensures the long-term

sustainability of working class communities by building and rehabilitating homes for first-time homeowners, running a small business incubator and developing residents’ job and leadership skills.

Becoming Proud Members of the *Community*

Exploring Durham’s neighborhoods with their tape recorders, a diverse group of Durham teenagers find and tell the stories that foster mutual understanding and collective spirit. Through the Youth Noise Network’s weekly radio show and other projects, they celebrate civic engagement, confront stereotypes, explore a broad range of issues and build ties

among different parts of their city. As they create audio documentaries, they develop technical skills, confidence – and a sense of responsibility towards their community.

“I like to think of sustainability in terms of three E’s – economics, the environment and equity,” says Frank Phoenix. “We could add a fourth E, education. An informed public will make good choices. And business is a powerful engine for getting things done. There’s a strong business case for sustainability – if we can harness business around the idea, change will come more quickly.”

Besides the radio show, YNN students have produced the *Passionate Citizens* project – nine profiles of Durhamites who have contributed to their community. Coordinator Tennessee Watson says, “They put the profiles out on an audio CD with an educator’s guide for civics teachers to use to bring the idea of civic engagement alive in the classroom. The students wanted to show many different forms of civic engagement, and they realized they already are civically engaged – they’re already doing it.”

Founded in 2003 by Durham teenagers, and still youth-driven and youth-led, the Youth Noise Network is a project of the Center for Documentary Studies at Duke University. It broadcasts on Duke’s station, WXDU 88.7 FM, every Sunday from 2 to 3 p.m.

“One of the first things Housing for New Hope did after its inception some years ago was establish a transitional home for men,” says Haywood Holderness. “At first, some nearby residents were resistant to having a public services recovery program in their neighborhood. But it soon became obvious that the men in the program made wonderful neighbors – serving on the neighborhood association, helping with clean-up and maintenance projects and making friends. The program continues to rebuild lives and build community.”

Donor Services

Linking donors to community needs

Across the community, Triangle Community Foundation fundholders are making Chatham, Durham, Orange and Wake counties better places to live. Individually and collectively, their vision, dedication and generosity continue to shape and improve our community and the world.

The Foundation's **Philanthropic Services Staff** work closely with donors to inform their giving and share pre-screened grantmaking opportunities. The Foundation is lucky to have an active, generous community of donors.

Through personal, one-on-one conversations, we encourage fundholders to think through personal values, motivations and goals as well as explore grantmaking avenues for fulfilling them. We also maintain a thorough collection of online and print philanthropic resources for fundholders' reference and use.

Additionally, the Foundation has seen more families become engaged in philanthropy. We have staff specifically trained in **family philanthropy** who help families consider their common values and interests as they establish grantmaking priorities.

At the core of these services is the grantmaking. Last year, the Foundation made more grants than ever before, mostly through donor-advised funds. We provide personalized **grantmaking services**,

offer information about grant opportunities and provide research and referral information on areas of particular interest to fundholders. We also measure and provide data regarding the impact of grants and help fundholders witness their dollars in action with site visits and progress reports.

Throughout the year, the Foundation offers fundholders several services and events, including:

EDUCATION

The Philanthropic Education Series offers educational forums on topics of interest and individual or group site visits.

COMMUNICATION

We communicate regularly about Foundation activities through the annual report, newsletters, quarterly updates and email reminders. This past year, we unveiled a new Web site and resource for donors, Donor Central.

INTERACTION WITH OTHER PHILANTHROPISTS

The quarterly Triangle Donors Forum series offers opportunities to interact with Foundation fundholders and other philanthropists in the community, learn from one another and work together on common interests. The Foundation is a proud member of the NC Network of Grantmakers, and fundholders can take advantage of the many program offerings of the group.

Create a Charitable Fund

Build our community – create a charitable fund

The Foundation works with hundreds of committed people to create innovative solutions to the most challenging problems in our region and beyond.

With a combined experience of over one hundred and forty years in nonprofit and finance, the staff provides unparalleled local knowledge, expertise and flexibility in managing the funds and meeting the goals of each fundholders' charitable giving. The Foundation offers several types of funds:

A **donor-advised fund** gives fundholders the power to recommend grants to organizations important to them. It lets them be actively involved in grantmaking and recommend grants to the charitable causes they value most.

A broad **field-of-interest fund** lets fundholders support causes they care about without having to choose specific organizations. The Foundation's expert Philanthropic Services staff identifies the nonprofit organizations that most effectively accomplish the donor's goals.

An **unrestricted fund** lets fundholders work together to support the community's greatest areas of need. Unrestricted funds also sustain the Foundation's Community Grantmaking Program, which supports agencies working on civic engagement and youth leadership and development.

A **designated fund** supports a specific charitable organization or program for a set period of time or in perpetuity. If the charity goes out of business, the Foundation protects the fundholder's interests by making grants to the organization most closely matching the original intent.

An **agency fund** lets nonprofit organizations benefit from the Foundation's professional endowment management and frees their staffs and boards to concentrate on their programs and mission. Agency funds include endowment funds that support organizations in perpetuity and non-endowed funds to establish cash reserves.

Scholarships provide essential support to deserving students in the Triangle and beyond. The Foundation administers the entire process from creating a managed scholarship fund to selecting recipients and disbursing funds. The Foundation also partners with educational institutions and shares responsibilities.

A **corporate-advised fund** allows companies to customize their giving programs. The Foundation helps corporations prioritize their charitable interests, establish corporate scholarship funds, make grants to assist those in need and create legacies with permanently endowed community funds.

Create a Charitable Fund *(continued)*

Planned giving vehicles include bequests, charitable remainder and lead trusts, and real estate gifts. The Foundation works with donors to achieve their financial, personal or business goals and leave permanent legacies to benefit charities important to them through named funds.

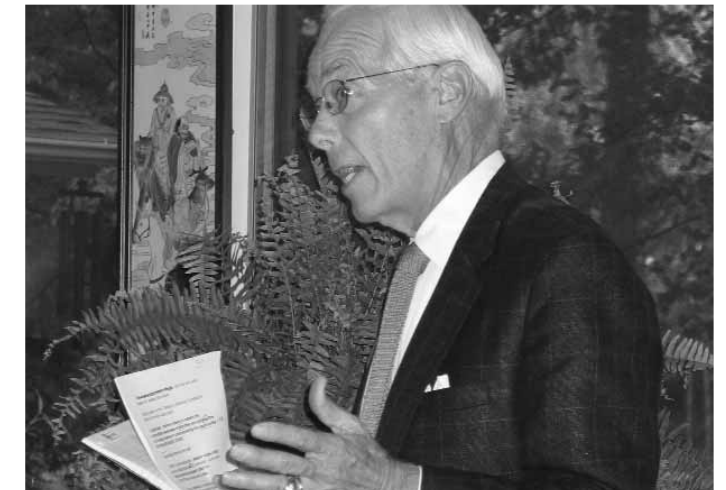

Financial Information

July 1, 2006 – June 30, 2007

Triangle Community Foundation carefully manages long-term philanthropic funds primarily for the benefit of Wake, Durham, Orange and Chatham counties in North Carolina. During the nearly 25 years of its existence, the Foundation's assets have grown from an initial contribution of \$3,000 to more than \$124 million, comprising nearly 650 funds. Over \$77 million of Foundation assets are in endowment funds. The remaining portion of assets is held in non-endowed funds that can be partially or fully expended. During the 2006-2007 fiscal year, contributions increased by over 65 percent while grantmaking increased by over 20 percent from the previous year.

The stewardship of the Foundation's funds is a critical responsibility of the Board of Directors. The Foundation's Finance Committee, appointed by and reporting to the Board of Directors, has immediate oversight of all aspects of the Foundation's financial management. This committee is comprised of Board members with specific experience and expertise in financial and operations management.

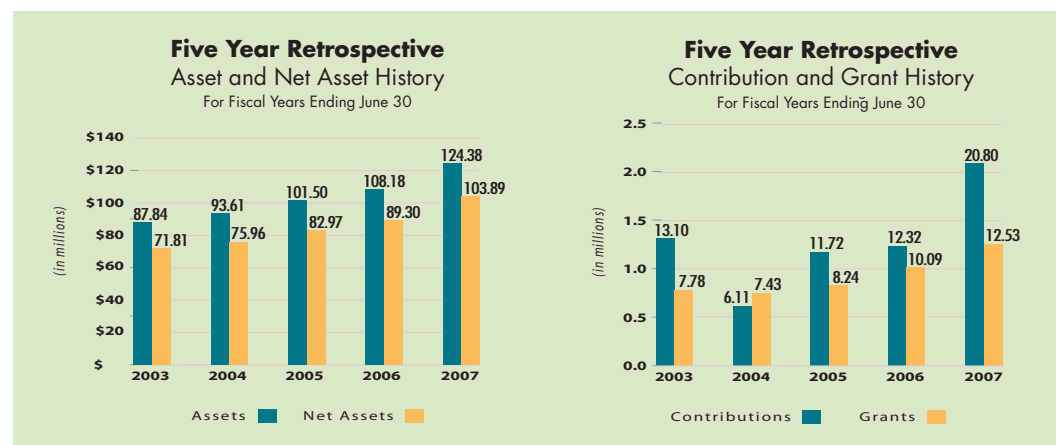
The Foundation's goal is to earn a reasonable return on its investments while maintaining a diversified, high-quality portfolio without undue risk of significant capital depreciation. Its investment policy, established and periodically reviewed by the Finance Committee, utilizes prudent investment strategies tailored to the unique needs of its charitable funds. It is

designed to result in growth sufficient to maintain the real value of a fund's principal balance and grantmaking capability over time. This is accomplished through carefully balanced portfolios of both equity and fixed-income securities and through the Foundation's total return spending policy.

The Foundation allows fundholders to recommend portfolios from among four specific asset allocation models, offering a range of exposures to equity and fixed income investments, each deemed prudent by the Foundation's Finance Committee. For funds not otherwise recommended by donors, the Foundation currently follows a targeted asset allocation model of 65 percent equity securities and 35 percent fixed income securities.

The Foundation employs professional investment management firms, which the Finance Committee selects and reviews. The Foundation's core investment portfolio is managed by the Russell Investment Group. In addition, the Foundation also maintains financial relationships with:
